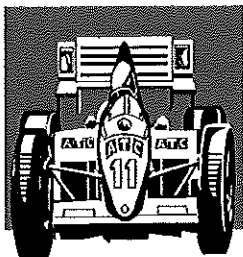

The February meeting was called to order by Assistant RE: Bobby Arnett. Minutes were approved as printed in the last newsletter.

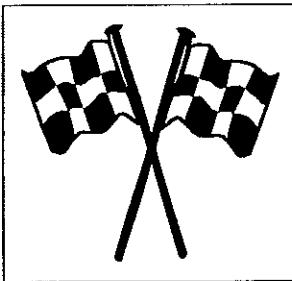
OLD BUSINESS

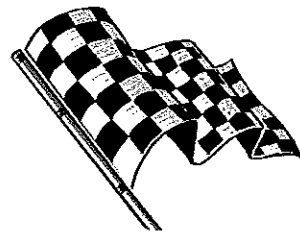
Thank you Outgoing Board !!

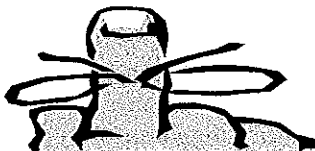

In the March newsletter I will be printing a racing schedule (tentative only) We are still in the process of trying to secure crucial sites.





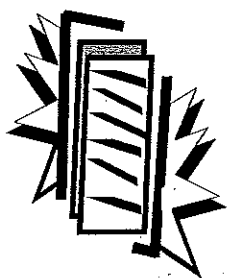
