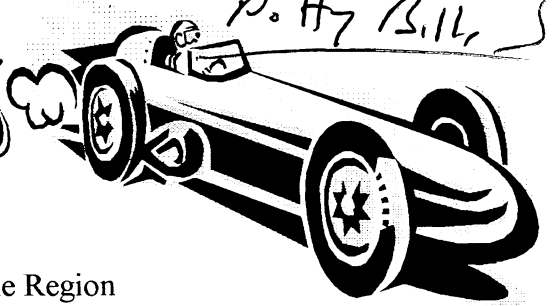

Colstrip had 12 entrants and will make about \$100.00 after all the fees etc.

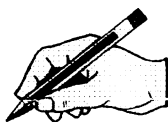
Scott commented about the difference between SCCA of 15 years ago and now and how much more professional we are now.

If you spot a dangerous situation, bring your concerns to the attention of the SSS. If there is no action and the dangerous situation continues to exist, it is then up to you to make the call to the National headquarters and have the sanctioning pulled for the event. Once that is done the event can not continue under SCCA sanctioning. So don't go acting like a bull in a china shop just because you are a SSS, use it wisely. Above all try to rectify any unsafe problems as you see them develop. It is always nice to have a second set of eyes when a course is being set up and the help in moving pylons and marking the course is always appreciated.

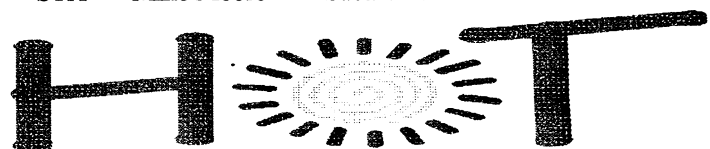
# COLSTRIP

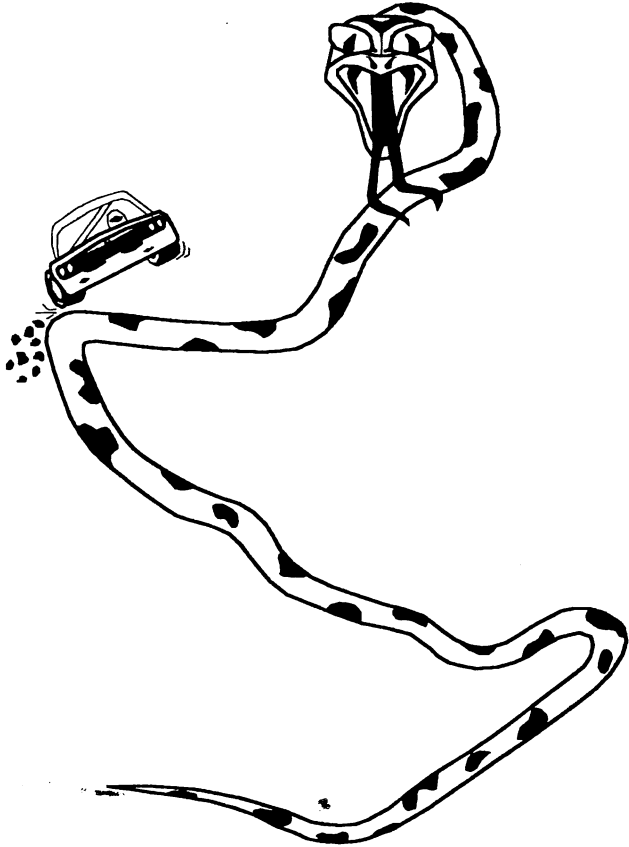

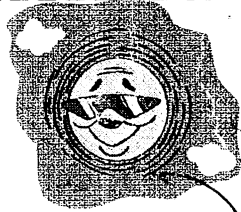

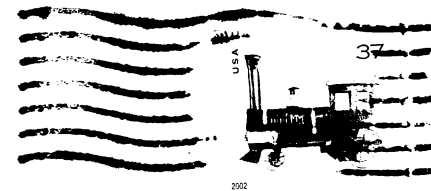
