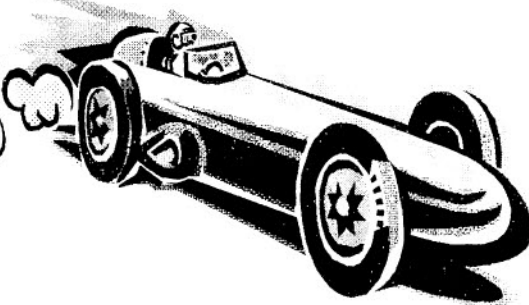

MEETING MINUTES - YELLOWSTONE REGION 108 - December Meeting

The April 4, 2007 meeting of Yellowstone Region was called to order by RE Kurt Schulz at 6:30 p.m. A motion was made, seconded and passed to accept the minutes of the previous meeting as published.

Treasurer's report: Treasurer Mark Richlen reported the current balance of the club's checking account. Richlen also reported that he had reimbursed himself for filing the annual report online.

Old Business: Scott Cranston thanked Kurt & Char Schulz for doing the newsletter and J. Ruess and family for taking care of the web site. Scott is still waiting on MSUB to confirm dates so he can finish the schedule. It was noted that the date for the Memorial Day event was erroneously listed in the newsletter and website. The correct date is Monday, May 28th. A discussion was held about continuing to use the Metra for events. The high cost and low profitability of Metra events was discussed. The 2006 event at the Metra lost more money than usual because a divisional Solo event took place the same week-end in Helena. Scott Cranston reported that he had not made a specific request for the Metra date this year, but would make an inquiry as to whether any dates were available. Scott & Steve Gruver reported that they had inspected the Yellowstone Drag Strip site in Acton, Mt. for future events. The facility is located 3 1/2 miles west of Acton and only 20 minutes from downtown Billings. Rent for the site is \$450.00 a day. Events would be limited to the paved pit area. The drag strip and related access roads would be off limits. Concessions would possibly be available. Scott moved, Steve seconded the club approach Yellowstone Drag Strip about using the site, motion carried. The possible dates included May 6, June 10 and June 24. It was generally agreed that this should be followed up on.

New Business: Scott Cranston moved that event fees for 2007 be raised to \$20.00 for members and \$30.00 for non-members, and event fees at higher-priced venues would be \$25.00 for members and \$35.00 for non-members. Mark Richlen seconded the motion and the motion passed. A discussion concerning circulating flyers and advertising future events. The consensus seemed to be that advertising would be beneficial. The younger guests and members in attendance offered some ideas about reaching target audiences that wouldn't otherwise be reached by previous radio and newspaper advertising. Some changes in this area looked promising. Also, rather than circulating advertising with schedules that may change or become outdated, it was agreed to encourage visits to the club website where information could be kept more up to date. A discussion took place regarding putting more information in the website about event starting times and tech inspections.
